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As part of your course grade, you will conduct a Supervised Agricultural Experience project. This project must meet the following requirements:

- Minimum 10 hours documented in your SAE Recordbook between February 1 and June 1.
- Create a budget by April 15.
- Complete a review/reflection page by June 1.

#### The project can be in many different forms:

- Entrepreneurship: you own the project (animal, create a business)
- Placement: work/volunteer for someone else (paid or unpaid)
- Exploratory: investigate a career path (job shadow, research)
- Research: conduct an investigation or experiment

#### Benefits of having an SAE:

- Career experience
- Meet graduation requirements
- Develop connections and network with potential future employers, community members
- Work ethic
- Evidence of employability

#### What counts as an SAE:

Any experience in the four categories above that is preparation for future careers and can be related (directly or indirectly) to agriculture.
